

- b. The name of the Son is Jesus.

*ST. MATTHEW 1:21 -- "And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call His name JESUS: for He shall save His people from their sins."*

- c. The Comforter is the Holy Ghost.

*ST. JOHN 14:26 -- "But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, He shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you."*

- d. Jesus is the Father.

*ST. JOHN 5:19-21 -- <sup>(19)</sup>"Then answered Jesus and said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, The Son can do nothing of Himself, but what He seeth the Father do: for what things soever He doeth, these also doeth the Son likewise. <sup>(20)</sup>For the Father loveth the Son, and showeth Him all things that Himself doeth: and He will show Him greater works than these, that ye may marvel. <sup>(21)</sup>For as the Father raiseth up the dead, and quickeneth them; even so the Son quickeneth whom He will."*

*ST. JOHN 14:7-12 -- <sup>(7)</sup>"If ye had known me, ye should have known my Father also: and from henceforth ye know Him, and have seen Him. <sup>(8)</sup>Philip saith unto Him, Lord, show us the Father, and it sufficeth us. <sup>(9)</sup>Jesus saith unto him, have I been so long time with you, and yet hast thou not known me, Philip? he that hath seen me hath seen the Father: and how sayest thou then, Show us the Father? <sup>(10)</sup>Believest thou not that I am in the Father, and the Father in me? The words that I speak unto you I speak not of myself: but the Father that dwelleth in me, He doeth the works. <sup>(11)</sup>Believe me that I am in the Father, and the Father in me: or else believe me for the very works' sake. <sup>(12)</sup>Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father."*
