

- e. The Name exalted.

*PHILIPPIANS 2:9-11 -- <sup>(9)</sup> "Wherefore God also hath highly exalted Him, and given Him a name which is above every name: <sup>(10)</sup> That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth; <sup>(11)</sup> And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.*

- f. The name gives us our inheritance; identifies who we are.

NAME: a word or words by which a particular person, place, or thing is distinguished from other persons, places or things.

Actually, in biblical times, the name was considered an extension or expression of the person himself. To speak "in the name of" was to express the thoughts or speak with the authority of the named individual. The "name of the Lord" is exalted because in His name God himself is suddenly present with the hearer, revealing both truth and His very self.
