

# JESUS

<i>Name/Title</i>	<i>Significance</i>
JESUS	His personal name, meaning "Yahweh saves"
CHRIST	The Greek word meaning "anointed one" or messiah.
LAMB OF GOD	A title indicating Christ's self-sacrifice in payment for sins.
LORD	A title of respect in most gospel occurrences, like our "Sir." In religious use, a title affirming deity and ultimate authority.
MASTER	A mark of respect used typically by those who were his followers.
MESSIAH	The Hebrew term for the "anointed one" whom God would send to establish His Kingdom on earth.
PROPHET	A person authorized to speak the word of God to man.
RABBI	"My great one," a mark of respect like our "Reverend."
SHEPHERD	Jesus is the "good shepherd" who lays down His life for the sheep.
SON OF DAVID	A messianic title reflecting Old Testament prophecies that the expected ruler would be of David's line.
SON OF MAN	A title used by Jesus of himself, reflecting His human identity, His role as man's representative before God. Also, reflects Daniel's (7:13-14) implications of deity.
SON OF GOD	A title affirming Jesus' unique relationship with the Father.
TEACHER	A mark of respect extended to one who taught the scriptures.
WORD	Logos in Greek. A term John used to show Jesus' unity with God and His role as a revealer of the Father.
